Established in 1922, the Royal Naval Benevolent Trust helps non-commissioned Sailors, Marines and their families, should they need help, throughout their lives. From the day they join the Royal Navy or Royal Marines, all RN ratings and RM other ranks are supported by the RNBT, as are their wives, husbands and dependent children.

The assistance provided includes targeted financial grants for specific individual needs, advice on welfare matters, regular charitable payments for those on especially low incomes and care of older beneficiaries at the Trust's residential care and nursing home near Chatham, Kent and an almshouse in Hornchurch, Essex.

CARE OF OLDER PEOPLE

The elderly in society are among the most vulnerable and RN and RM veterans are no exception. We run a 6-unit almshouse for those able to care for themselves and a 55 bed residential care and nursing home with spacious en-suite accommodation plus modern and welcoming public rooms. The residents enjoy a wide range of outings and activities and there are strong links with the Royal Naval and Royal Marine Associations.
